Young students in the Tampa Bay area can celebrate Zoo Story by designing “ZooWrap” wrapping paper that features the animals of Lowry Park Zoo. A wide array of materials may be used, including crayons, paint, collage, markers, construction paper cutouts and photo images from the Times Zoo Story series. It is suggested that entries are filled with colorful images that will look good when used as a repeating pattern. Computer graphics or store-bought stencils or stamps are not allowed.

Students in grades K-5 may submit one original design each on 8 1/2- by 11-inch sheet of unlined paper, accompanied on the reverse side by the child’s name, age, address, telephone number and school. Entries must be received at the Times St. Petersburg location (490 First Ave. South) by 5 p.m. Friday, Dec. 14.

The winning design will be printed and inserted into the Times the following weekend as a sheet of wrapping paper for thousands of Times readers to use for those last minute gifts. Additional sheets will be available for use by nonprofits that do gift wrapping in area malls for charitable purposes. Student prizes include a \$25 first-place gift card and ten finalist awards of “I’m in the know. I read the Times” backpacks, pencils and Subway sandwich coupons.
